**This** TRUST DEED is made the *thirteenth* day of *January*

One thousand nine hundred and seventy-five By the PARISH COUNCIL OF LONGFORD in the County of Gloucester (hereinafter called "the Council" which expression shall where the context so admits include the Council's successors in title)

W H E R E A S

1. The Council is seised in fee simple in possession free from incumbrances of the land and roadway described in the First Schedule hereto

2. The Council has agreed to hold the said land and the Village Hall intended to be erected thereon and the right-of-way over the said roadway described in the First Schedule upon the trusts hereinafter described NOW in consideration of the premises This Deed Witnesseth as follows:-

1. THE Interpretation Act, 1889 applies for the interpretation of this deed as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament
2. THE Council is the Trustee of the Longford Village Hall (hereinafter called "the Charity")
3. THE Council shall hold the said land with the Village Hall to be erected thereon upon the trusts and subject to the powers and provisions set out in the Second Schedule hereto

IN WITNESS whereof John William Sivell and Stanley Edgar Evans two members of the Council have pursuant to a resolution of the Council passed on the *thirteenth* day of *January* One thousand nine hundred and Seventy-five hereunto set their respective hands and seals the day and year first before written

THE FIRST SCHEDULE hereinbefore referred to

ALL THAT piece or parcel of land forming part of a larger piece or parcel of land situate in the Parish of Longford in the County of Gloucester and being part of enclosure number 92 on the Ordnance Survey Map for the said Parish (1936 Edition) All which said property is more particularly delineated on the plan annexed hereto and thereon edged red Together with a right-of-way with vehicles or otherwise at all times and for all purposes over and along the roadway coloured green on the said plan being the entrance from Longford Lane to the Council's Playingfield

THE SECOND SCHEDULE above referred to.

Village Halls Trusts.

Clause 1. (1) The property hereby conveyed (hereinafter called "the Trust Property") shall be held upon trust for the purposes of a Village Hall for the use of the inhabitants of the Parish of Longford in the County of Gloucester (hereinafter called "the area of benefit") without distinction of political, religious or other opinions, including use for meetings,
